These things are not private or limited to college students.

Use the privacy settings on the system.

**The general default usually makes it available to everyone who accesses the site.

Hidden Hazards:

Identity Theft, Sexual Predators, Stalkers, Cyber Predators, Cyber Threats, Harassment, Blackmail, Faults sense of Security, and Addition.

<u>Cyber Stalking or Harassment</u> includes repeated and unwanted contact through the Internet that is rude or threatening. Never respond to harassing or rude comments. Print and delete unwanted comments from your profile or friends who leave inappropriate comments on your profile.

Print it Save it Report it.

When your personal safety is threatened or in danger report it to the service provider and your local police.
