Operation ID is a nationwide program to prevent property theft and burglary. This is done by marking your personal property with your permanent identification number.

The Problem

If your property lacks positive identification, it creates problems for you!

- Recovered property cannot be traced and returned to you. It may be auctioned off, destroyed or even returned to the thief upon demand.
- Criminals can profitably move your stolen goods through pawnshops, second-hand stores, etc. with little chance of apprehension.
- Without positive identification, your property may not be used as evidence against the criminal, and he or she could be released without being held accountable for the crime committed against you and your family!



Protect your property! Don't become a victim!

The Solution

Use this Valuable Property Record and store it in a secure, fireproof place with other valuable papers, preferably in a location other than the home.

- Record the make, model, serial numbers and value of all items.
- Mark all your property with your state abbreviation letters followed by your driver's license number using an electric engraver, marking pen or permanent marker.

Example: TX 12345678

• For smaller valuables that cannot be marked (such as jewelry), arrange for closeup, color photographs as a means of identification, and store them with this Valuable Property Record.

Other Crime-Prevention Tips

Contribute to the security of your residence by being alert to any suspicious activity. Report it at once!

- If you are calling from an on-campus telephone, dial 9-911.
- If you are calling from an off-campus telephone, or cellphone, dial 911.
- For on-campus non-emergencies, call (979) 845-2345.

- 2. Lock your doors.
- 3. Do not leave any items in your car.
- 4. Be cautious of strangers or strange phone calls.
- 5. Keep your smaller valuables such as jewelry and coin collections in a safe deposit box.
- 6. Do not leave smartphones, laptops, tablets, backpacks, purses or wallets unattended.
- 7. Lock your bikes with a case-hardened steel lock to the bike rack and run a cable through both tires.


