Crime Prevention

Two of the most common crimes occurring in Bryan/College Station are vehicle burglary and vehicle theft. Listed below are some suggestions for the citizens of this community to use in an effort to reduce these offenses.

- 1. Never leave the keys in the vehicle.
- 2. Always lock the doors, even when you are away from the vehicle for a short time.
- Remove items (purses, tapes, C.D.'s books, etc.) from the vehicle when possible or put in place out of view.
- 4. Remove "pull-out" style stereos (if equipped).
- Park in garages, on driveways, or near your apartment so the vehicle can be viewed periodically.
- Register vehicle in the Help End Auto Theft (H.E.A.T.) program with Bryan Police or College Station Police.

- Steering wheel lock bar or steering column locking cover.
