Crime Prevention

Two of the most common crimes occurring in Bryan/College Station are vehicle burglary and vehicle theft. Listed below are some suggestions for the citizens of this community to use in an effort to reduce these offenses.

1. Never leave the keys in the vehicle.
2. Always lock the doors, even when you are away from the vehicle for a short time.
3. Remove items (purses, tapes, C.D.'s books, etc.) from the vehicle when possible or put in place out of view.
4. Remove "pull-out" style stereos (if equipped).
5. Park in garages, on driveways, or near your apartment so the vehicle can be viewed periodically.
6. Register vehicle in the Help End Auto Theft (H.E.A.T.) program with Bryan Police or College Station Police.

OTHER VEHICLE SECURITY CONSIDERATIONS

1. Steering wheel lock bar or steering column locking cover.
2. "Engine Kill" switch.
3. Car alarm.
