A&M Introduces Its 1st Dutch Junction!

What's a Dutch Junction? It's a type of junction developed in the Netherlands that works to make roads safer for cyclists and drivers. It incorporates concrete islands at intersection corners. This separates cars and cyclists turning right and moves the cyclists into the view of cars and out of their blind spot. The junction is also marked with green paint. Not only does this illustrate where the bike pathways are, it illuminates at night for cyclists by storing solar energy during the day and emitting the stored energy at night. Parking and Vehicle Alternatives

- Park and Ride
 - No direct bus route where you live? Use the Park and Ride Stop (at First Baptist Church of College Station) & hop on Route 34!
- Zipcar
 - Join Zipcar and reserve a car for 1 hour to a week with gas and insurance included! You can even choose the car you drive.
- Ride Share
 - A&M Transportation & the Environmental Issues Committee partnered to bring this network for ridesharing to Aggies. Make a profile, search for seats, or post your own ride destination all in one!
- Break/Weekend Shuttles
 - The Kerrville Bus Company (Coach USA) offers weekend/holidays rides to Dallas, Houston, and Grand Prairie. They even have connectivity with Megabus to other destinations! Weekend shuttles leave Friday and return Sunday.

- There are 1,300 bike racks on campus. This equals 13,000 bike parking spaces!
- A&M has 10 FIXIT Stops across campus for you to repair your bike.

GREEN BIKE LANES AT ROSS & BIZZELL

MAKING CAMPUS SAFER FOR EVERYONE



PEDESTRIANS

- 1 do not block or stand in protected bike lanes
- 2 wait in protected areas until able to cross street
- 3 cross street using white dashed lanes
- 4 watch for people on bicycles before crossing bike lanes even if you have right of way



CYCLISTS

- 1 use protected green bike lanes to navigate intersection
- 2 slow down before entering intersections and crosswalks
- 3 watch for crossing vehicle traffic at intersection
- 4 after yielding to people walking at crosswalks, advance to the end of the center island and cross with caution



MOTORISTS

- 1 when turning, yield to people walking and cycling
- 2 be aware of raised concrete islands in the intersection
- 3 follow the white dotted lines when making left turns
