ROOMMATE/ROOM SELECTION PROCESS TIMELINE

LATE-APRIL

Receive Roommate Selection Instructions

Residence Life

DIVISION OF STUDENT AFFAIRS

- Includes date the process will become available
 Includes specific instructions on how the process
- works and what you will need to do

LATE-APRIL to MID-MAY

Roommate Selection Process Opens

- We recommend matching with roommates during this time period (before Room Selection begins) so that you have the best chance of getting what you want with your desired roommate
- Technically, you will have access to the Roommate Selection process from this time through the rest of the summer
- *May 1st deadline* Accept admission / sign up for your New Student Conference or cancel oncampus housing application without penalty

MID-MAY

Receive Room Selection Instructions

- Includes timeslot date that the process will become available
- Timeslots are determined based on the date you originally applied for housing (Housing Priority Date)
- The earlier you applied for housing, the earlier your timeslot, meaning more available housing options to choose from. Includes instructions on how the process works and what you need to do

LATE-MAY to MID-JUNE

Room Selection Timeslots Open

- This is when you will actually choose your housing for 2018-2019
- Once your Timeslot opens, you will have access to the Room Selection process from that time through the rest of the summer. This means, if someone else cancels or moves from a space you may have wanted, you can move yourself into that space

REMINDERS

- You can confirm that you have completed your on-campus housing application, log into your housing portal at
- https://oncampusaggies.tamu.edu, log in with your NetID, then go to your application status page.
- You can update your housing application at any point during the process
- You still have access to opt in/out of the Roommate Finder process and to update your preferences on the Roommate Questionnaire at any time.

IF YOUR PLANS HAVE CHANGED....

- Student have until May 1st to cancel their on-campus housing without incurring a late cancellation penalty.
- All housing cancellations must be "in writing" either through the on-line process at https://oncampusaggies.tamu.edu,
- Log in with your NetID, or send an email to <u>housing@tamu.edu</u> with your name, UIN, and a statement to cancel your Fall 2018 housing application.
 Declining your Admissions will NOT automatically cancel your bausing.
- Declining your Admissions will NOT automatically cancel your housing.
